All Concessions

at the 2008 Hope Brigade Days are set up outdoors on the 6th Avenue fairgrounds in Hope, for the weekend of September 5, 6 and 7. Space allotted is at least 10' x 10' and one 8' table per applicant. Where possible, applicants should bring their own tents or trailers, as only a limited number of tents are available locally. If tents and hook-ups or any other specialities are needed such requirement(s) must be indicated on the application form., which must be returned to the organizers **before August 25th, 2008.**

Set Up

for all concessions is to take place **between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m. on Friday, September 5th.** If this is not possible, please notify Hope Brigade Days - prior to that Friday - by calling 604-869-2744 to arrange for set-up on Saturday from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. On arrival, report to the grounds manager, who will direct you to your allocated spot and hand you two Briggie Buttons and one Car Pass. **Within the fairgrounds a Briggie Button must be worn by every person over the age of 12** - extra buttons are available from the grounds manager at the discounted price of \$5.00 each. The Car Pass allows one vehicle to enter the gates during the weekend for purposes of set-up and take-down, or when supplies need to be replenished.

Take-Down

takes place between 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. Sunday afternoon. **Earlier departure only possible by arrangement with the grounds manager.**

Insurance

All applicants must provide proof of acceptable liability insurance before set-up is allowed.

Deposit

A deposit of \$100.00 is required with every application, which amount is deducted from final fee. In case of a no-show, this deposit is forfeited unless notice of cancellation is received by noon, September 3, 2008

Fees

are set out on a two-tier basis, as follows:

A - Sales Concessions

Fee calculated at 10% of gross sales less deposit.

Includes all merchandizing and food concessions. Grounds manager will collect these fees at around 3:00 p.m. on Sunday (unless otherwise agreed).

B - Non-Sales Concessions

Fee is \$100.00, paid with application

Includes all public relations activities, hand-outs, etc. as defined on the application..
